

Welcome from the Managing Director

A lot has happened over the last three months, and I am delighted to be able to share SmartSec's activities for the last quarter in this letter.

As promised, I am pleased to update you on our Net Carbon Zero Plan. This is a significant step for SmartSec, as we have engaged a specialist consultant to guide us. The consultant is currently developing our plan, which aims to achieve Carbon Neutrality by 2040, a decade ahead of the government's 2050 deadline for organisations. This proactive approach underscores our commitment to sustainability.



In June, we hosted our Summer Party, which was a great success. I want to take this opportunity to thank our colleagues who attended. My head office colleagues and I really enjoyed getting to meet you all. I hope you enjoyed the day and had the opportunity to meet new colleagues and catch up with colleagues whom you may not have had the chance to see in a while.

SmartSec has continued to grow and win new contracts over the last quarter. Since I last wrote to you, we have been awarded seven new guarding sites and a number of keyholding sites. In addition, SmartSec was awarded a large security consultancy contract from one of the leading global law firms based in the UK, further expanding our reach across new sectors.

SmartSec was also awarded a framework contract for a large local authority further expanding our market share in the local government sector.

In support of SmartSec's continued growth, we have created the position of Head of Strategy and Major Accounts. We appointed David Taylor to this position, which was an internal promotion following his transfer to us on the 20 Old Bailey Account. This new position will provide support for existing major customers and focus on opening new doors to SmartSec and expanding our exposure to the marketplace, generating new opportunities for us.

SmartSec is currently working on a number of projects in sectors such as finance and legal, which is part of our diversification strategy. I am hopeful that I will have some positive news related to these to share in my next letter.

SmartSec Solutions continues to support the local communities in which we operate. Over the last quarter, SmartSec partnered with Onwards and Upwards, who are a part of Barnet Council that specialises in supporting Young Care Leavers. Following the HR team and I presenting to these young people, a number of them expressed an interest in joining the private security industry. We have so far placed six young people with SmartSec and other private security companies. This partnership will continue well into the future, with SmartSec assisting young people joining our industry, fulfilling the industry' 's recruitment needs whilst helping the local community.

In addition to the above, SmartSec is now a sponsor of Running on Empty. This initiative encourages physical well-being, which, by proxy, enhances mental well-being. Shortly, new resources related to this will be shared with all SmartSec colleagues, encouraging you to get involved.

SmartSec Solutions front-of-house sites participated in Global Wellness Day across our receptions, as well as Red Nose Day and International Women's Day. SmartSec Solutions also joined industry colleagues from the member companies of the City Security Council in volunteering as stewards to ensure the safety of those joining Figen Murray OBE in the last leg of her 200-mile walk to Downing Street to push for the introduction of Martyn's Law.

We have continued to work closely with the City of London Police, arranging crime prevention days on some sites to promote personal safety and participating in events that promote our industry, such as the hi-visibility events we have continued to support alongside the City Security Council and the City of London Police.

We have now transitioned to Timegate, our new business operational management system. We fully transitioned on 1st May 2024 and are commencing the rollout of our employee portal. This is being trialled with a few sites throughout July and will be available to all colleagues by the end of August at the latest. This portal will give you access to apply for and manage your annual leave, view your shifts, and keep updated on all SmartSec policies.
